AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 694

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "terms" in line 4 down through "office," in line 5; in line 9, strike "annual" and substitute "certain"; and in the same line, after "Council," insert "providing for the termination of this Act;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 20, strike "23" and substitute "25".

On page 3, in line 16, strike "AND"; after line 16, insert:

"(XV) THE SPECIAL SECRETARY OF THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES OR THE SPECIAL SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(XVI) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, OR THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE; AND";

in line 17, strike "(XV)" and substitute "(XVII)"; and in line 21, strike "STAFF" and substitute "COORDINATE THE STAFFING OF".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 28 on page 3 through line 3 on page 4, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, in line 4, strike "(H)" and substitute "(G)"; in line 5, after "CONSULT" insert "ON A PRO BONO BASIS"; strike in their entirety lines 7 through 17, inclusive; and in lines 18, 20, 23,

(Over)

27, and 30, strike "(3)", "(4)", "(5)", "(6)", and "(7)", respectively, and substitute "(2)", "(3)", "(4)", "(5)", and "(6)", respectively.

On page 5, in lines 15, 18, and 20, strike "(8)", "(9)", and "(I)", respectively, and substitute "(7)", "(8)", and "(H)", respectively; in line 20, strike "AND ANNUALLY ON JULY 1 THEREAFTER" and substitute ", JULY 1, 2002, AND JUNE 30, 2003"; and strike in their entirety lines 29 through 35, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 5, in lines 20 and 21, strike "TASK FORCE" and substitute "ADVISORY COUNCIL"; and in line 27, strike "about" and substitute "providing that either the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene or the Maryland State Department of Education shall provide".

AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 6, in line 1, strike "4." and substitute "3."; and in line 2, after "2000." insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
