A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - State's Attorney's Office - Composition and**
3 **Salaries**
4 **PG 311-01**

5 FOR the purpose of increasing the annual salary of the State's Attorney for Prince
6 George's County beginning with a certain calendar year; altering the number of
7 assistant State's Attorney positions in the State's Attorney's office; increasing
8 the maximum salaries of the deputy State's Attorneys, the assistant State's
9 Attorneys, and the administrative assistant in the State's Attorney's office;
10 providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the
11 incumbent State's Attorney; and generally relating to the composition of and
12 salaries in the office of the State's Attorney of Prince George's County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 10 - Legal Officials**

22 (q) In Prince George's County:

- 23 (1) (i) The State's Attorney's annual salary shall be:
- 24 1. \$107,775 for calendar year 1999;
 - 25 2. \$107,775 for calendar year 2000;
 - 26 3. \$111,000 for calendar year 2001; [and]

1 [\$56,000] \$59,000. The salary is to be paid by the County on the certification of the
2 State's Attorney to the County Executive and County Council. The administrative
3 assistant is not subject to the rules and regulations of the County merit system, but
4 shall be entitled to all benefits provided for County employees under the merit
5 system.

6 (8) The salary and expenses of the State's Attorney, the deputy State's
7 Attorneys, and the assistant State's Attorneys shall be paid in equal semimonthly
8 installments.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
10 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
11 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Prince George's County
12 in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
13 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Prince George's County shall take
14 effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2001.
