1 AN ACT concerning

2                                   **Election - Compensation of Election Judges - Prince George's County**  
3                                   **PG 316-01**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the compensation of election judges in Prince George's  
5 County by a certain amount; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary  
6 or compensation of the incumbent election judges in Prince George's County;  
7 and generally relating to the compensation of election judges in Prince George's  
8 County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article 33 - Election Code  
11 Section 10-205(b)(5)  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (1997 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16                                   **Article 33 - Election Code**

17 10-205.

18 (b) (5) (i) In Prince George's County, the compensation for each election  
19 day actually served shall be:

- 20                                   1.       [\$150] \$200 per day for two chief election judges; and
- 21                                   2.       [\$100] \$125 per day for every other election judge.

22                                   (ii) 1.       In Prince George's County, except as provided under  
23 sub-subparagraph 2 of this subparagraph, election judges and alternate election  
24 judges shall receive \$25 as compensation for completing the course of instruction  
25 required under § 10-206 of this subtitle.
