A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration – Driver Improvement Program/Point System**
3 **Conferences (DIP/PSC) Pilot Program or Program**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Motor Vehicle Administration, unless specifically
5 authorized by law, from offering or authorizing the Driver Improvement
6 Program/Point System Conferences (DIP/PSC) Pilot Program or Program
7 provided over the Internet; and providing for the termination of this Act.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 **12–121.**

17 **UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY LAW, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY**
18 **NOT OFFER OR AUTHORIZE THE DRIVER IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM/POINT**
19 **SYSTEM CONFERENCES (DIP/PSC) PILOT PROGRAM OR PROGRAM THAT IS**
20 **PROVIDED OVER THE INTERNET.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2007. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of
3 September 30, 2009, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
4 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
