A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Individuals with Developmental Disabilities Respite Care – Sunset Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination provisions relating to the requirement
4 that State residential centers operated by the Department of Health and Mental
5 Hygiene provide respite care; and generally relating to respite care and
6 individuals with developmental disabilities.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Chapter 178 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004
9 Section 4

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Chapter 178 of the Acts of 2004**

13 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2004. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of
15 September 30, 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
16 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 July 1, 2007.
