10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)				
<p>Shady Grove Adventist Hospital, is a not-for-profit, acute care facility with 268 licensed beds that is located in Rockville, Maryland. Shady Grove is committed to delivering excellent health care through a ministry of physical, mental and spiritual healing. The hospital offers a broad range of health services and is recognized for excellence in emergency care; high-risk obstetrical and neonatal care; cardiac and vascular interventional care; as well as a broad range of surgical specialties. Also, Shady Grove Adventist Hospital for Children, which is located within Shady Grove Adventist Hospital encompasses a broad range of specialized services for children, including the first Pediatric Emergency Department in Montgomery County and the only Pediatric Intensive Care Unit in the county.</p> <p>Shady Grove Adventist Hospital is part of Rockville, Maryland-based Adventist HealthCare, an integrated health care delivery system that is one of the largest employers in the state of Maryland. Adventist Healthcare also includes Washington Adventist Hospital, Potomac Ridge Behavioral Health System, Adventist Rehabilitation Hospital of Maryland, Adventist Senior Living, Adventist Health Careers Training Center, Hackettstown Community Hospital, and Adventist Home Health. 11. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

Shady Grove Adventist Hospital is a member of Adventist HealthCare, a non-profit health care system comprised of three acute care hospitals, a free-standing inpatient rehabilitation hospital, a freestanding behavioral health hospital, several nursing centers, a home health agency and other health care related services. Our mission is to deliver excellent health care through a ministry of physical, mental and spiritual healing.

The purpose of this project is to provide comprehensive, prenatal, obstetrical care for low income and uninsured pregnant women residing in Montgomery County. Most of these women are not eligible for Medical Assistance but are in need of prenatal and obstetrical care. Multiple prenatal visits, per ACOG guidelines, and accepted medical standard for perinatal care will be provided at the center, as well as related gynecological services, including Pap smears, sexually transmitted disease screens and HIV screening, counseling and appropriate treatment will be offered to participants. Shady Grove Adventist Hospital has entered into a partnership with Montgomery County to provide this care. We recognize the importance of working collaboratively to ensure these services are available and accessible.

The proposed project would be constructed within leased medical office spaces and includes the costs to plan, design, construct and manage the build-out of an 2,000 gross (1,800 net) square foot maternity center suite. The suite will have a waiting and reception area, business and administrative offices, consultation room, two exam rooms, and clinic support spaces (blood draw, utility rooms, restrooms, etc.)

Initial center space will be provided three days a week through an existing temporary shared Department of Health and Human Service center space. This application is seeking assistance for our long term plans to develop clinic space in Germantown. Approximately 1,800 square feet of office space will be used to help treat the volume of patients expected to be served, as well as to increase the number of days of service per week beyond what is currently being provided. It is anticipated that the Maternity Partnership Program will continue to grow as it has in the past. In fact, Montgomery County has Maryland’s largest number of immigrants compared with all counties in the state and this trend is expected to continue.
