A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment – Phosphorus – Dishwashing Detergent**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the date by which certain persons are prohibited from
4 using, selling, manufacturing, or distributing for sale certain dishwashing
5 detergent that contains greater than a certain amount of phosphorus; and
6 generally relating to phosphorus in dishwashing detergents.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Environment**

20 9–1502.

21 This subtitle does not apply to a cleaning agent that is:

22 (1) A detergent used in dairy, beverage, or food processing cleaning
23 equipment;

1 (2) A phosphoric acid product, including a sanitizer, brightener, acid
2 cleaner, or metal conditioner;

3 (3) A detergent used in hospitals, veterinary hospitals or clinics, or
4 health care facilities or in agricultural production;

5 (4) A detergent used by industry for metal cleaning or conditioning;

6 (5) Manufactured, stored, or distributed for use or sale outside of the
7 State;

8 (6) Used in any laboratory, including a biological laboratory, research
9 facility, chemical laboratory, and engineering laboratory; or

10 (7) Used in a commercial laundry that provides laundry services for a
11 hospital, health care facility, or veterinary hospital.

12 9–1503.

13 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a person may not use,
14 sell, manufacture, or distribute for use or sale within the State any cleaning agent
15 that contains more than 0.0 percent phosphorus by weight expressed as elemental
16 phosphorus except for an amount not exceeding 0.5 percent phosphorus that is
17 incidental to manufacturing.

18 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a person may use, sell,
19 manufacture, or distribute for use or sale a cleaning agent that contains greater than
20 0.0 percent phosphorus by weight, but does not exceed 8.7 percent phosphorus by
21 weight that is:

22 (1) A detergent used in a dishwashing machine, whether commercial
23 or household; or

24 (2) A substance the Secretary, by rule and regulation, excludes from
25 the 0.0 percent phosphorus limitation of subsection (a) of this section based on a
26 finding that compliance with this section would:

27 (i) Create a significant hardship on the user; or

28 (ii) Be unreasonable because of the lack of an adequate
29 substitute cleaning agent.

30 (c) After [January 1, 2010] **JULY 1, 2010**, a person may not use, sell,
31 manufacture, or distribute for use or sale within the State any detergent for use in a
32 household dishwashing machine that contains more than 0.5 percent phosphorus by
33 weight.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2008.
