CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Failure to Yield Right-of-Way – Penalties for Death or**
3 **Serious Bodily Injury**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing that if a person fails to yield the right-of-way in
5 violation of certain provisions of law and the violation contributes to an accident
6 that results in the death or serious bodily injury of another, the person is
7 subject to a certain fine and the Motor Vehicle Administration is authorized to
8 suspend the person's license for a certain period of time; providing that a
9 licensee may request a hearing on a license suspension imposed under this Act;
10 and generally relating to penalties for a failure to yield the right-of-way that
11 contributes to an accident that results in death or serious bodily injury.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Transportation**

2 (A) IF A PERSON VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF TITLE 21, SUBTITLE 4
3 OF THIS ARTICLE AND THE VIOLATION CONTRIBUTES TO AN ACCIDENT THAT
4 RESULTS IN THE DEATH OR, AS DEFINED IN § 27-113 OF THIS SUBTITLE,
5 SERIOUS BODILY INJURY OF ANOTHER, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A
6 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION:

7 (1) THE PERSON IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
8 \$1,000; AND

9 (2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND THE PERSON'S LICENSE
10 FOR NOT MORE THAN 180 DAYS.

11 (B) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 12, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS
12 ARTICLE, A LICENSEE MAY REQUEST A HEARING ON A LICENSE SUSPENSION
13 IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 July 1, 2008.
