A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Sex Offender Registry – Identifying Information**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that the registration statement of an individual required
4 to register as a sex offender include the registrant's current or former aliases,
5 names, nicknames, chat room identities, computer log-in or screen names,
6 Internet identities, and instant-messaging identities that the registrant has
7 used; and generally relating to registration statements of sex offenders.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

16 11–706.

17 (a) A registration statement shall include:

18 (1) the registrant's full name, including any suffix, and address;

19 (2) (i) for a registrant under § 11–704(a)(7)(i) of this subtitle or
20 who is on work release, the registrant's place of employment; or

21 (ii) for a registrant under § 11–704(a)(7)(ii) of this subtitle, the
22 registrant's place of educational institution or school enrollment;

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (3) (i) for a registrant enrolled, or expecting to enroll, in an
2 institution of higher education in the State as a full-time or part-time student, the
3 name and address of the institution of higher education; or

4 (ii) for a registrant who carries on employment, or expects to
5 carry on employment, at an institution of higher education in the State, the name and
6 address of the institution of higher education;

7 (4) a description of the crime for which the registrant was convicted;

8 (5) the date that the registrant was convicted;

9 (6) the jurisdiction in which the registrant was convicted;

10 (7) a list of any **CURRENT OR FORMER** aliases, **NAMES, NICKNAMES,**
11 **CHAT ROOM IDENTITIES, COMPUTER LOG-IN OR SCREEN NAMES, INTERNET**
12 **IDENTITIES, AND INSTANT-MESSAGING IDENTITIES** that the registrant has used;

13 (8) the registrant's Social Security number;

14 (9) any other name by which the registrant has been legally known;
15 and

16 (10) the registrant's signature and date signed.

17 (b) If the registrant is a sexually violent predator, the registration statement
18 shall also include:

19 (1) identifying factors, including a physical description;

20 (2) anticipated future residence, if known at the time of registration;

21 (3) offense history; and

22 (4) documentation of treatment received for a mental abnormality or
23 personality disorder.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 October 1, 2008.
