## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Procedure - Restitution - Priority to Victims**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a provision of law so as to provide that payment of  
4 restitution to a victim has priority over any payments to any other person or  
5 governmental unit, subject to certain exceptions; and generally relating to  
6 restitution.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article - Criminal Procedure**

21 11-606.

22 (a) The court may order that restitution be paid to:

23 (1) the victim;

1 (2) the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Criminal  
2 Injuries Compensation Board, or any other governmental unit;

3 (3) a third-party payor, including:

4 (i) an insurer; or

5 (ii) any other person that has, under Part I of this subtitle:

6 1. compensated the victim for a property or pecuniary  
7 loss; or

8 2. paid an expense on behalf of a victim;

9 (4) any person for whom restitution is authorized by law; or

10 (5) a person who has provided to or for a victim goods, property, or  
11 services for which restitution is authorized under § 11-603 of this subtitle.

12 (b) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection **AND § 11-617(B) OF**  
13 **THIS SUBTITLE**, payment of restitution to the victim has priority over [payment of  
14 restitution] **ANY PAYMENTS** to any other person or governmental unit.

15 (2) If the victim has been fully compensated for the victim's loss by a  
16 third-party payor, the court may issue a judgment of restitution that directs the  
17 restitution obligor to pay restitution to the third-party payor.

19 (b) Subject to federal law, the order of priority of execution of an earnings  
20 withholding order is:

21 (1) first, an earnings withholding order issued under § 10-128 of the  
22 Family Law Article;

23 (2) second, an earnings withholding order issued under this section;  
24 and

25 (3) lastly, any other lien or legal process.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
27 October 1, 2008.
