2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 **Article - Tax - General**

5 11-204.

6 (a) The sales and use tax does not apply to:

7 (8) a sale to a bona fide nationally organized and recognized
8 organization of veterans of the armed forces of the United States or an auxiliary of the
9 organization or one of its units, if the organization is qualified as tax exempt under §
10 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code.

11 **Chapter 217 of the Acts of 2006**

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 July 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of [3] 6 years and, at the end of June
14 30, [2009] 2012, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
15 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

16 **Chapter 218 of the Acts of 2006**

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 July 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of [3] 6 years and, at the end of June
19 30, [2009] 2012, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
20 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 June 1, 2009.
