1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Cecil County – Regulation of Domestic Animals**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Cecil County, by
4 ordinance, to provide for certain regulation of certain domestic animals and
5 certain hybrids of domestic and wild animals; and generally relating to the
6 regulation of domestic animals in Cecil County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 24 – Political Subdivisions – Miscellaneous Provisions

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 24 – Political Subdivisions – Miscellaneous Provisions**

15 11–511.

16 (a) This section only applies to Carroll County, **CECIL COUNTY**, and
17 Frederick County.

18 (b) In addition to and not in substitution for any powers granted under this
19 article, the county commissioners, by ordinance, may provide for a comprehensive

1 system for the regulation of domestic animals, including dogs, and wild animals held
2 in captivity, within the county, including licensing and control.

3 (c) These regulations may include:

4 (1) Provisions for the impoundment and disposal of unlicensed or
5 dangerous dogs;

6 (2) Provisions for the regulation of persons who own or keep any
7 animal which disturbs the peace and quiet of a neighborhood, or which is vicious; and

8 (3) Reasonable penalties for violations of any of the provisions of the
9 regulations, not to exceed imprisonment in the county jail for 30 days or a fine of \$500,
10 or both.

11 (d) The county commissioners:

12 (1) May regulate animals that are hybrids of domestic or wild animals;
13 but

14 (2) May not regulate or control wild animals that are not owned or
15 kept by individuals.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2010.
