1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Education**

4 2–202.

5 (c) (1) The student member shall be:

6 (i) A regularly enrolled student; and

7 (ii) In good standing in a public high school in the State.

8 (2) The student member may attend and participate in an executive
9 session of the Board.

10 ~~¶~~(3) The student member may not vote on any matter that relates to:

11 (i) The dismissal of or other disciplinary action involving
12 personnel; **OR**

13 ~~(ii) Budget; or~~

15 § 6–202 of this article.‡
