A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Institutions of Higher Education – Course Credit – Advanced**
3 **Placement and International Baccalaureate Examinations**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring public institutions of higher education in the State to
5 grant comparable course credit for Advanced Placement and International
6 Baccalaureate examinations under certain circumstances; and generally
7 relating to Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate examinations.

10 Section 15–101.1
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 **15–101.1.**

17 **IF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE GRANTS**
18 **COURSE CREDIT FOR ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS, IT SHALL GRANT**
19 **COURSE CREDIT FOR STANDARD AND HIGHER LEVEL INTERNATIONAL**
20 **BACCALAUREATE EXAMINATIONS COMPARABLE TO THE COURSE CREDIT**
21 **GRANTED FOR ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2011.
