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## Preface

2011 Special Session  
(October 17, 2011 – October 20, 2011)

By Executive Order (01.01.2011.19, October 12, 2011), Governor Martin O'Malley called the General Assembly into a Special Session on Monday, October 17, 2011. The Special Session adjourned *sine die* on Thursday, October 20, 2011.

A total of 55 bills were introduced during the Special Session, of which 32 were Senate bills and 23 were House bills. Of the 55 bills that were introduced, three bills, Senate Bills 1, 2, and 3, were passed by both Houses. They became Chapters 1, 2, and 3 of the Special Session.

Pursuant to Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, the 2011 Regular Session bills vetoed by the Governor were considered during the Special Session. All of the vetoes were sustained.

The Synopsis portion of this publication covers all the bills that were signed by the Governor in order by chapter number. There is a brief description of the subject matter of each Act, as well as a reference to the introductory bill number and the name of the member who introduced the bill. The words "Amended" or "Enrolled" indicate that the bill was amended during its passage through the two Houses. The word "Emergency" indicates that the law became effective upon approval by the Governor.

The Status portion of this publication contains indexes of all bills introduced, compiled by Sponsor, Committee, Statute, Final Status, and Subject.
