AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 207
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 5, after “arsenic;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act under certain circumstances; requiring the State Department of Agriculture to provide a certain notification; providing for a delayed effective date;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

After line 19, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) This Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect with respect to the specific arsenical additive receiving approval by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration if the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, on review of new information under 21 C.F.R. Part 514, issues a finding that:

- (1) approves the use of the arsenical additive;
- (2) includes in its approval an evaluation of:
 - (i) human food safety;
 - (ii) impact on the environment;
 - (iii) safety to animals;
 - (iv) effectiveness of the drug for its intended use;
 - (v) chemistry and manufacturing procedures; and

(Over)

(vi) water quality impacts to the Chesapeake Bay; and

(3) exposure to the arsenical additive is unavoidable and necessary.

(b) The State Department of Agriculture shall notify the Department of Legislative Services within 5 days after the action under subsection (a) of this section occurs.”

AMENDMENT NO. 3

In line 20, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”; and in line 21, strike “October 1, 2012” and substitute “January 1, 2013”.
