CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Occupational and Professional Licensing Design Boards – Sunset Provisions**
3 **and Program Evaluation**

4 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Certified Interior Designers in
5 accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset
6 law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the
7 statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; requiring that an evaluation of
8 the Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to the Board be
9 performed on or before a certain date; repealing certain termination provisions
10 relating to the Occupational and Professional Licensing Design Boards' Fund
11 and the authority of certain occupational and professional licensing design
12 boards to set fees; and generally relating to the occupational and professional
13 licensing design boards.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

13 8–602.

14 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland
15 Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall
16 terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2014] **2024**.

17 **Article – State Government**

18 8–403.

19 (a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a
20 governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a
21 preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this
22 section.

23 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (a) of this section, on or before
24 the evaluation date for the following governmental activities or units, an evaluation
25 shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and
26 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:

27 (32) Interior Designers, State Board of Certified (§ 8–201 of the
28 Business Occupations and Professions Article: July 1, [2013] **2023**);

29 **Chapter 227 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 273 of the Acts of**
30 **2008**

31 [SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 2 and 6 of this
32 Act shall remain effective for a period of 10 years and 1 month and, at the end of June
33 30, 2013, with no further action required by the General Assembly, these sections
34 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 July 1, 2012.
