A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages – Follow-Up Criminal History Records Checks**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Criminal Justice Information System Central
4 Repository (CJIS) to provide local licensing boards with a revised printed
5 criminal record statement of a license applicant or license holder if information
6 is reported to CJIS after the initial criminal history records check is completed;
7 requiring CJIS to stop providing the local licensing boards with revised printed
8 statements under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; and generally
9 relating to criminal history records checks of alcoholic beverages licensees and
10 license applicants.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

1 (a) (19) "Local licensing board" means a board of license commissioners of a
2 county or the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis.

4 (F) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "CJIS" MEANS THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE
5 INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
6 PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

7 (2) WHEN CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION OF AN
8 APPLICANT OR LICENSE HOLDER IS REPORTED TO CJIS AFTER THE INITIAL
9 CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK IS COMPLETED, CJIS SHALL PROVIDE
10 THE LOCAL LICENSING BOARD WITH A REVISED PRINTED STATEMENT OF THE
11 CRIMINAL RECORD OF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSE HOLDER.

12 (3) IF THE LOCAL LICENSING BOARD INFORMS CJIS THAT AN
13 INDIVIDUAL IS NO LONGER AN APPLICANT OR LICENSE HOLDER, CJIS SHALL
14 STOP PROVIDING THE LOCAL LICENSING BOARD WITH REVISED PRINTED
15 STATEMENTS OF THE CRIMINAL RECORD OF THE INDIVIDUAL.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 July 1, 2012.
