1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government – Commemorative Days – Harriet Tubman Day**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor annually to proclaim a certain day as
4 Harriet Tubman Day; and generally relating to commemorative days.

7 Section 13–410

8 Annotated Code of Maryland

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – State Government**

13 **13–410.**

14 **THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM MARCH 10 AS HARRIET**
15 **TUBMAN DAY.**

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2012.
