

Committee Vote Records

Committee votes may be found under the Documents section on the Bill page. When a committee vote is available a link is provided to the committee's Vote Record. Vote Records are stored in PDF format.

The final recorded committee roll call vote on a bill serves as a recommendation on the bill to the full house and becomes part of the committee report to be considered on the floor at the bill's second reading. To understand a committee vote tally, one must determine the motion that was proposed. Was the motion favorable, unfavorable, etc.

The final action recorded by the committee may be:

- FAV (Favorable) - A bill reported to the floor of the chamber by a committee with a "favorable" recommendation carries no committee amendments with it. The report may be adopted or rejected on the floor.
- FWA (Favorable with Amendment(s)) - A bill reported to the floor of the chamber by a committee with a "favorable with amendment(s)" recommendation carries committee amendments. The report may be adopted or rejected.
- UNF (Unfavorable) - A bill reported to the floor with an unfavorable recommendation does not progress further in the process.
- REI (Referred to Interim Study) - A committee takes this action to refer a bill for committee study during the nine-month interim.
